- before the heading in the upper left corner, the index (in regular font) of the UDC is marked (in accordance with the rubricator of the Universal Decimal Classification);
- the title of the article or thesis is written in the center in bold on the top lines; below the heading, in the center, write the name, surname (in bold and in open form): author'(s) academic degree and

academic title, the name of the country, place of work and study (title for doctoral students and dissertators), email address, mobile phone number (in italics, see **Sample**);

- the references is marked at the end of the text in alphabetical order and in accordance with the requirements of the Higher Attestation Commission (the number of the referenced literature is indicated in the text: example, [2]).

The inclusion of the article (thesis) in the conference materials will be determined by the relevant sections. If necessary, the article (thesis) will be corrected and resubmitted based on the comments and remarks of the section. The article (thesis) will not be included in the conference materials if the comments and remarks of the section are not accepted and corrected and sent in time.

Submitted materials will not be sent back.

Only one material will be accepted as authorship or co-authorship from one person.
